Welcome back to Mass: I wish to welcome you back to Mass today. I hope you and your family are well and delighted to be back. Jesus casts his gaze upon each person here today. Cradien Mass Begins on Sunday 12th July 2020: We begin the celebration of the Sunday Mass in St Josephs Church on Sunday 12th July 2020 at 9.30am. We thank those people who volunteered as Stewards, and Helpers in insuring that the regulations asked of us by the Northern Assembly, and the Bishops are put in place. It is important that the regulation of keeping **two metres apart, and sanitizing ones hands, into and out of the Church is strictly adhered to by everyone.** The helpers will help all to feel relaxed, and at home when we arrive in Church. As the Church can only hold 40 people when the regulations are in place, we ask those who want to come to Mass to ring the following number to insure that you have **booked your seat in the Church** for Mass. The Number to ring is 07866 174766 (Thurs & Fri (2-5pm). As we know the Sunday obligation to attend Mass in church has been set aside owing to the pandemic, so we ask you not to get disappointed if there is no place left for you in the church when you ring. You can follow Mass on the webcam until a place is available for you in the church. Don't get upset as we are in a new situation. You can only do your best, and we can only do our best also. We will introduce more Masses in the parish gradually during the week, but this will be a gradual process.
