LET THE CHILDREN COME TO ME AND DO NOT STOP THEM: We know too well that it is good for our children to play sports. We are grateful to those who organise football and sports for them. However we are not happy to see our young children, some whom have only received First Communion, being enticed away from Mass on Sunday by having football training while Mass is being celebrated in the Church/ or at 12-00 noon which means they cannot attend Mass. Jesus says: “Let the children come to me and do not stop them” Of course it is the responsibility of parents to encourage their children to go to Mass on Sunday, and to accompany them. But all parishioners have a responsibility to help them. We all know that the Church founded by Christ is going through a hard time, and Jesus needs help from everyone at this time. He is **not** saying to us to stop children playing sport, but he is asking us not to put obstacles in their way of coming to Mass. We know from some parents that few parents in our parish agree with the times set out for children on Sunday. They should let their voice be heard, for their responsibility is to be treasured. Parents are the first teachers of their children in the ways of Faith. They should have a say in all that involves their children. Parents know intuitively how to protect their children on Sunday mornings and to demand better for them, while Mass is being celebrated in the Church. This is at the heart of their vocation. Our Diocese has been very generous in making grounds available to our children, and parishioners to play games. However they didn't make the grounds available so that children would be asked to play games at an inappropriate time on Sunday Morning. After all Sunday is the Lord's Day. And Jesus has a say. Jesus has told us how it is to be spent. We, as a parish have enough generosity to let the children come to Jesus on Sunday, and not put obstacles in their way. We should show our appreciation to the Diocese for its generosity to our children, rather than belittling that generosity. I know that this reminder will awaken our conscience, and help us find a suitable time, for the children of the parish. The good of our children and of their parents spiritually, mentally, and physically is always the deciding factor! The Altar in a parish is the centre of a parish. Jesus calls us around the Table of the Lord on Sunday. We should never quieten his voice. I hope this notice is taken with the same loving mentality with which it is given, and that parents will make their voice heard to accompany the voice of Jesus. “Let the children come to me and do not stop them”
