The Bishops of Ireland will undertake a pilgrimage to the International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine in Knock. At the Mass the bishops will also offer prayers of thanksgiving for all those who selfishly sacrificed so much during the pandemic. The Bishops invite everyone to join with them in Prayer on this solemn occasion.

Blessing of the Graves in Edenmore Cemetery: Here in Tempo after 11.00am Mass on today 14/11/2021, we will have the blessing of the graves. We too will remember all our dead and especially all those who have died during the pandemic. We ask all to bring a small bottle of Holy Water and to sprinkle it on the family Grave during the blessing. Holy Water is available in both Churches. In this way all of us will show solidarity with those grieving their dead especially those who lost a love one during the pandemic. "God of the living and the dead, accept our prayers for those who have died and are buried with him in the hope of the Resurrection. Since they were true to your name on earth, let them praise you now for ever in heaven"
