World Missions Ireland: Mission Sunday is coming up shortly. World Mission Sunday is celebrated on Sunday 18th October 2020. The theme of “Mission Sunday” this year is **“Together we can do more—Blessed are the peacemakers”**. It is important that we are not shy about supporting the Mission on this Sunday. It is important also that we know something about Mission Sunday. Why? Because our parish, and our diocese is a missionary parish, and a missionary diocese! Jesus calls on us to be missionary, and to support the Missions. In other words he asks us to support Dioceses abroad who may not be as well off as we are. As we know the needs of Missionary Dioceses vary greatly. We may be asked to provide a priest on the missions with a motor bicycle, so that he can celebrate Mass in a remote village, or a Community Hall that will allow people to gather in safety, or more urgently to provide vaccinations, and medicines to protect vulnerable children in parish dispensaries. We may be asked to help in building schools, clinics, parish halls, and churches. We may be asked to help prepare future leaders and carers for the church abroad. We will be asked too, to support missionary programmes that protect and care for children’s spiritual and physical well being by offering safe shelter, health care, education, and hope for the future.

Who organises World Mission Sunday? We in Ireland have a group called **“World Mission Ireland”** and many other countries have a similar group. We are part therefore of a global network which includes 120 countries, each of which organise for their own country. Fr Michael P O Sullivan is National Director of **“World Mission Ireland”**. Each Year representatives from each of the 120 international offices meet in Rome for the National Assembly. During this week--long meeting, funding requests from Missionary Dioceses are reviewed, identifying those with the greatest need. Each International Office or group is then assigned specific missionary projects. I consider the mission collection as one of the most important collection of the year. Therefore, I ask everyone to hand in their parish envelope for Mission Sunday.
