Holy Week: Today we begin the most important week in the Church's calendar. This is Holy Week and every follower of Christ makes this week very special. Today is Palm Sunday to be followed by Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday. On Holy Thursday we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist, and the ordination of the first priests. On Good Friday we celebrate the suffering and death of Jesus on the Cross for our sins, and on Holy Saturday Night we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. When saying the rosary it is important to remember that we meditate on all these events in our Rosary. We find the Eucharist in the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. We find the agony in the garden, the scourging at the pillar, the crowning with thorns and the carrying of the cross and crucifixion in the sorrowful mysteries of the rosary. We find the resurrection in the Glorious mysteries of the Rosary. It is good therefore to pray the rosary during this week. Unfortunately we can only have fifty people in the church for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday Night and Easter Sunday because of the pandemic. During the Holy Thursday Liturgy we cannot have the washing of the feet. During the Good Friday Liturgy we cannot have the kissing of the Cross. It will be kissed by the priest alone. During the Holy Saturday Night Ceremony we cannot have the lighting of the Paschal Fire, the Lighting of the Paschal Candle. In Palm Sunday we begin with the blessing of Palms, and palms will be left in the church for anyone who would like to have some palm after the ceremonies. On Holy Thursday we will have a box in the church for Trocaire boxes. For those who will not be present in the Church for these ceremonies it is important to follow them on line.

We can only have 50 people present at each ceremony and booking is required. The wearing of masks is mandatory in Churches.
