The Most Holy Trinity: There are three persons in the Holy Trinity. Our God is a Community of persons. We are made in the Image of God. This means that we are made for relationships with God and with one another. We are relational people, and we develop our individuality through relationships. The big word in Christianity is relationships. The big question in Christianity is: How are you developing in your relationship with God and with one another: we are to love God and to love one another, and we depend on God and on one another.

INTERCEDING FOR OTHERS--REFLECTING ON THE FINGERS ON MY HAND:

THUMB: This is the finger nearest the heart. I pray for all those I love, and who love me, and for dear ones.

FOREFINGER: Used in teaching and directing. I pray for those who instruct others - teachers, parents, priests, and bishops. **MIDDLE FINGER:** This is the tallest finger. I pray for all who rule in Church and Government - those in authority.

FOURTH FINGER: This is the weakest finger. I pray for those who are ill, those undergoing trials and difficulties, dying bereaved, oppressed, abused, vulnerable powerless and lonely. I pray for children-babies born and unborn and for the elderly. **LITTLE FINGER:** This is the smallest finger, the last and the straightest. It most resembles "I" so I pray for myself and for all my needs. I pray that I may grow in awareness of God's presence, and that I may grow closer to Him.
